- **Thursday, August 6, 2015** 2-4 pm at Ashley Pond in Los Alamos, NM. Join us to mark the 70th anniversary of the U.S. atomic bombing of Hiroshima with the annual sackcloth and ashes peace vigil and call for nuclear disarmament near the National Labs, with reflections by Rev. Jim Lawson and Roshi Joan Halifax.
- **Friday, August 7, 2015** 9am-4pm. Join Ken Butigan, Veronica Pelicarić, and the Pace e Bene/Campaign Nonviolence staff for a pre-conference intensive day of nonviolence training at the Santa Fe Hilton - 100 Sandoval St. Santa Fe, NM
- **Friday-Saturday, August 7-8, 2015.** Join with leaders, activists and peacemakers from around the nation to reflect on nonviolence, energize the grassroots movement to abolish war, poverty, nuclear weapons and environmental destruction, and build Campaign Nonviolence. Speakers include Rev. Jim Lawson, Prof. Erica Chenoweth, Roshi Joan Halifax, Rev. John Dear, Kathy Kelly, Ken Butigan, Kit Evans-Ford, Rev. Lennox Yearwood, Marian Naranjo and Beata Tsosie-Pena from the New Mexico Pueblo and many others. **The conference will be held at The Hilton Hotel, 100 Sandoval St. Santa Fe, NM off the plaza.** It begins Friday night, August 7, 2015 from 7 p.m. – 9 p.m. beginning with the opening keynote. Registration will run from 5 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. The conference will resume Saturday morning August 8, 2015 from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m.
- **Sunday, August 9, 2015,** 11:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. at Ashley Pond in Los Alamos, NM. Finally, join us to mark the 70th anniversary of the U.S. atomic bombing of Nagasaki with the annual sackcloth and ashes peace vigil and call for nuclear disarmament near the National Labs with reflections by Rev. Jim Lawson, Kathy Kelly, Medea Benjamin, Rev. Lennox Yearwood, Beata Tsosie-Pena from the New Mexico Pueblo and others. Veterans for Peace will provide round-trip bus transportation from the Hilton Hotel in Santa Fe to Los Alamos and back.



## LOGISTICS: ▼

**MEALS:** A vegetarian bag lunch will be provided for those attending the pre-conference nonviolence training on Friday, August 7th and the Saturday, August 8th conference. Coffee and tea will be provided only on Saturday, August 8th. No breakfasts or dinners are provided during the August 6th-9th events. The downtown Santa Fe plaza, which is one short block away from the Hilton, has many places to eat. Visit the [Santafe.org website](http://Santafe.org) for a list of dining options.

**LODGING:** Hotels and Motels in Santa Fe for early August may be completely filled by June 1st 2015 due to a variety of events in and around the Santa Fe area at that time, so be sure to reserve your hotel stay soon. The Santa Fe Hilton during this peak season runs close to \$240+ per night. If you'd like to reserve a room at the Santa Fe Hilton now you can do so here, or call 505-988-2811. Other hotels within walking distance that we recommend are:

- [Santa Fe Desert Inn](#), 311 Old Santa Fe Trail, Santa Fe, 505-982-1851 (about \$140 a night, a 10 minute walk to the Hilton)
- [Santa Fe Sage](#), 725 Cerrillos Rd., Santa Fe. 505-982-5952 (about \$119 a night, a 15 minute walk to the Hilton)
- [Motel 6 Plaza Downtown](#), 646 Cerrillos Rd., Santa Fe. 505-982-3551 (about \$90 a night, a 15 minute walk to the Hilton)
- A twenty minute drive from the downtown plaza, on [Cerrillos Road going south](#), there are many other hotels such as Motel 6, Hampton Inn, Budget Inn, etc. You can find a full list of Santa Fe accommodations on the [Santafe.org website](#). Public buses also run up and down Cerrillos road directly into downtown Santa Fe. One way cost \$1.00

**TRANSPORTATION:** Those driving into Santa Fe can find driving distances and times listed on the [Santa.org website](#). For those flying, some airlines fly into Santa Fe directly, however flights are generally cheaper coming into Albuquerque. If you rent a car, the drive from Albuquerque is a little over an hour from Albuquerque to Santa Fe and there is a large public parking garage across the street from the Hilton hotel. There is also a train that runs from Albuquerque to Santa Fe that costs roughly \$8-\$10 one way called the NM Rail Runner Express. Shuttle services are also available from the Albuquerque airport to Santa Fe. Learn more about these options on the [Santafe.org website](#). Once in Santa Fe, the Hilton Hotel is located at [100 Sandoval St. Santa Fe, NM 87501](#). If you need more information on public transportation options and other means of getting around Santa Fe visit the [Santafe.org website](#). Keep in mind, *we are not able to provide transportation to and from Los Alamos on Thursday, August 6th*, however we will provide bus transportation to and from Los Alamos on Sunday, August 9th. When you register below, please indicate if you plan to use this bus.
